

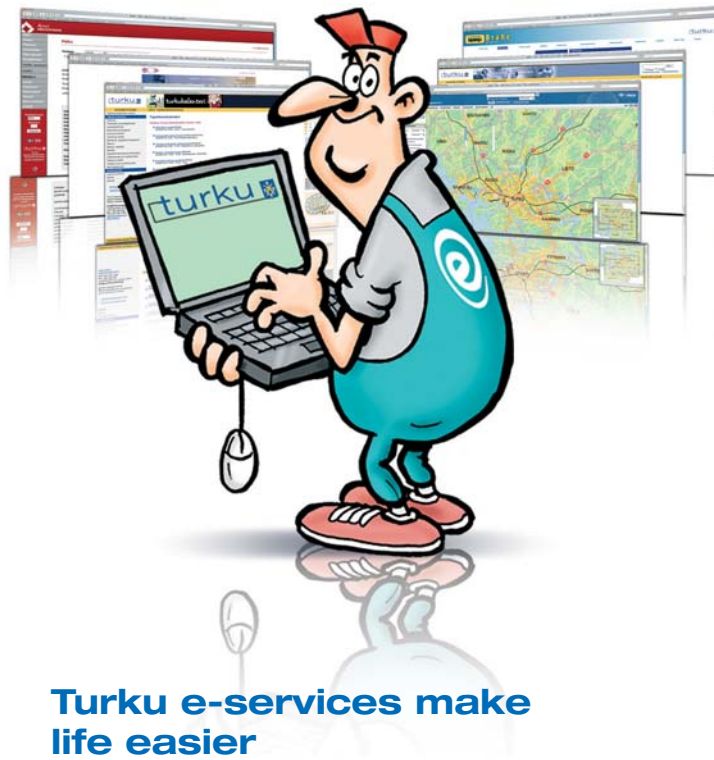


Web services are easy to use

In Turku you have wireless access to the internet in almost every area of the city, since SparkNet is the largest wireless net in Finland. SparkNet is used by both the public and the private sector, thus serving approximately 100 000 users. OpenSpark is a Wi-Fi user community, which you can join by letting other community members use your own wireless access point. There are more than 2 000 OpenSpark and Sparknet access points at present.

Turku Event Calendar tells what's on in the city

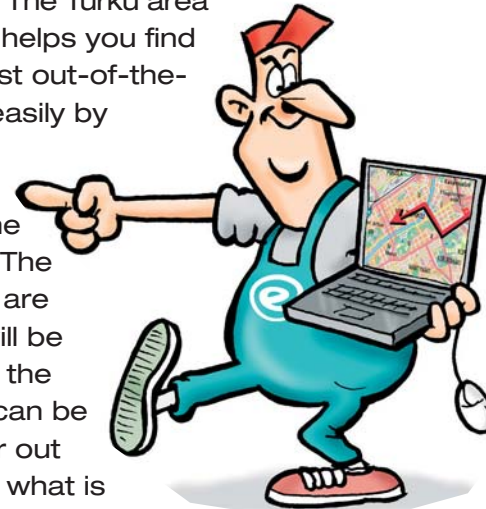
The Event Calendar maintained by the City of Turku keeps you informed of what's going on
