



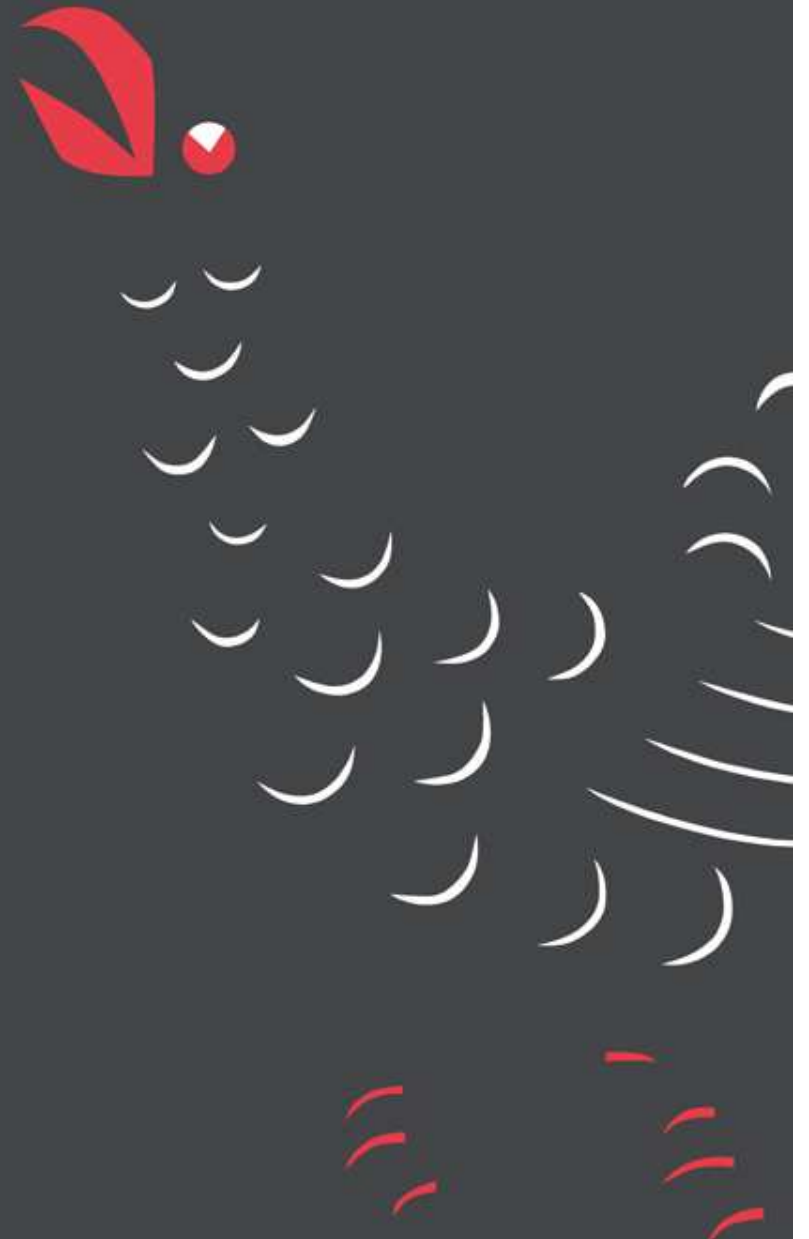

Bioeconomy has significant contribution to economy

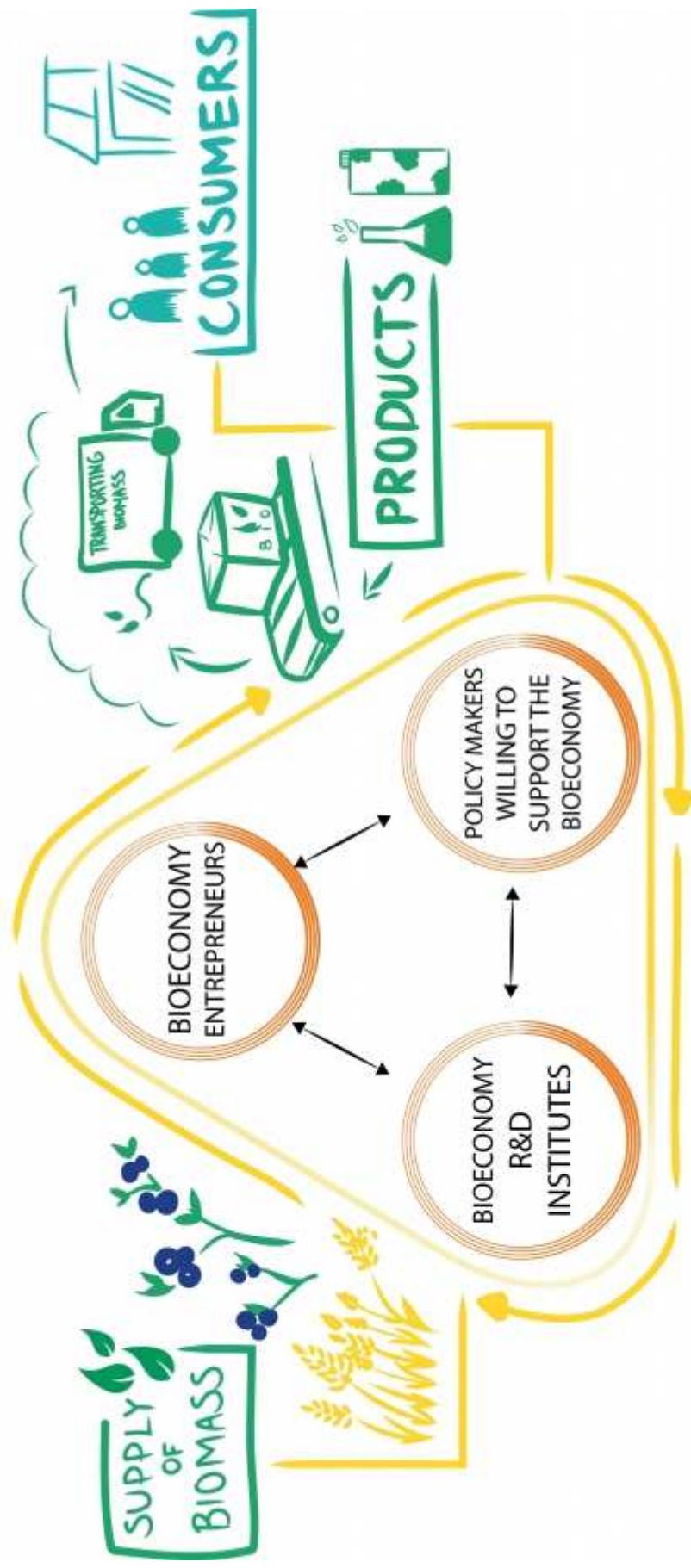
EU Bioeconomy strategy highlights the importance of **regional bioeconomy agendas**

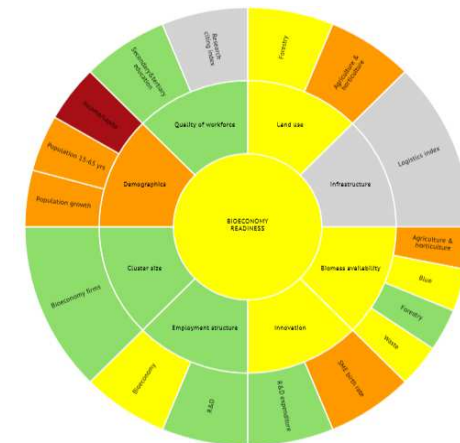
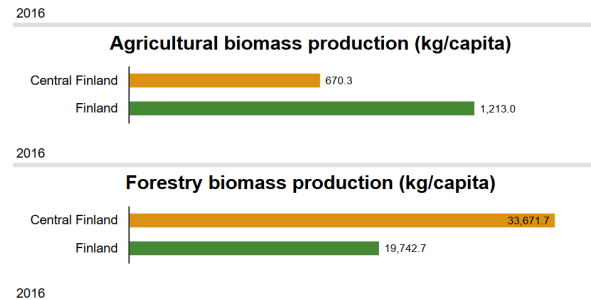
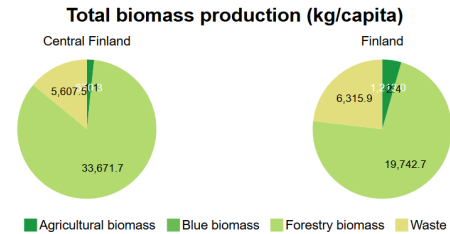
